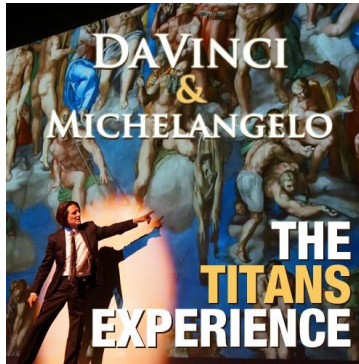

DaVinci and Michelangelo: The Titans Experience is set to open on August 15th 2019 at St. Luke's Theatre with tickets selling through January 5th 2020.
